NOTES

1. All Items on the above list MUST be IAW AR 670-1, i.e. all patches sewed on, serviceable, proper nametapes (Gortex Jacket) and proper fit.
2. Female soldiers need only one belt.
3. IAW AR 670-1, jungle boots are not authorized to be worn in formation when uniformity is required. Jungle boots will not be worn for Land Navigation and the STX during winter months. Jungle boots are not a substitute for black leather boots. Black leather boots must be IAW AR 670-1 and one set must be initial issue. Tanker and Hi-tech boots are not authorized. Soldiers deployed to the Desert may substitute the brown combat boot.
4. Accessories include cotton inserts for chemical protective gloves. Green or Black overshoes replaced chemical protective overshoes.
5. To prevent embarrassing situations after duty hours, soldiers are required to be appropriately attired (not just undergarments) when walking down hallways and walking to and from showers, latrines and washrooms.
6. Bring frame, all straps and belts required for use with the rucksack (ALICE pack).
7. Deployed soldiers may substitute DCUs for BDUs, but must have 4 duty uniforms.
8. Shoes oxford black will be used for the Dining In for **all** males and pumps for females. All will wear Class A uniform (Dress Configuration) with white shirt and black bow tie or necktab.
9. Personnel who are on medication need to bring enough medication to last the duration of the cycle. This is to include allergy medications and bee sting kits.
10. Part I of the Pre-Execution Checklist must reflect that the soldier has all appropriate clothing and equipment. The 7th Army NCO academy will only issue missing items under the following circumstances:
 - (a) Coordination is made with the Commandant **BEFORE** the student arrives at PLDC.
 - (b) The soldier presents a memorandum listing the missing items and the reason why the unit could not obtain the items.
 - (c) The above memorandum is signed by the first LTC in the soldier's Chain of Command. It is the responsibility of the unit to correct all equipment shortages within the first week of PLDC. Soldiers missing items **will not** be allowed to compete for honors. Soldiers still missing Packing List Items at 72 hours, will be released from the course.
 - (d) Deployed soldiers **do not** require a memorandum if deployment precludes them from having necessary Class A uniform items.
