Brig. Gen. Christopher R. Norrie is the commanding general for the 7th Army Training Command, Grafenwoehr, Germany. He took command on June 11, 2019.

Brig. Gen. Norrie most recently served as the Deputy Commanding General for Maneuver, 1st Cavalry Division, Fort Hood, Texas.
