

TAB1 (Summary of Current Bavarian Corona Restrictions) to ANNEX A to General Order No. 1H

1. CURRENT BAVARIAN ORDINANCE. (Bav. Ord.) The 16th Bavarian Ordinance containing COVID-19 restrictions was originally enacted on **1 April 2022** and is effective through **31 May 2022**.

2. FFP2 MASK REQUIREMENT. (Bav. Ord. § 2). Masks are only required in medical facilities, public transportation, and homeless and/or refugee centers. In situations where masks are required, FFP2 is the required mask. Children ages 6-16 may wear surgical masks. Children under 6 are exempt from the mask requirement. Note: Business owners reserve the right to require masks at their own discretion even in establishments where the law does not strictly require it. Please check with the establishment ahead of time to be sure.

3. VACCINATED, RECOVERED OR TESTED (3G) (Bav. Ord. § 3). Visitors to hospitals, nursing homes, correctional facilities, detention centers, psychiatric hospitals and youth welfare homes have to be vaccinated, recovered or tested in order to be allowed access. Those who are vaccinated or recovered have to provide additional proof of a negative COVID tests to enter the facility.
