

**1. METHODOLOGY.** This Annex defines varying levels of restrictions on movement, mode of travel, proscribed limits on group sizes and socializing, and specific types of off-limits establishments. The restrictions applicable to each military community within the 7ATC SRO Area of Responsibility are identified in the “Limitations in Effect” at paragraph 6. In addition, I may indicate a specific geographic location as off-limits by listing it below at paragraph 2.e.

**2. TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS.** Exception authority to this paragraph generally is O-5/GS-14 Commanders or Supervisors. I reserve the authority to approve exceptions for travel to any destination listed as a “risk area” by the Robert Koch Institute (RKI) (link at “g.” below).

a. Minimize movement and contact to the maximum extent possible.

(1) Soldiers assigned to On-Post Single Soldier Barracks are restricted from leaving their installation of residence, except for travel to neighboring military installations for supplies and essential errands such as grocery shopping, medical and pharmacy appointments, banking, postal services, and vehicle maintenance and fueling.

(2) Soldiers assigned to Off-Post Housing, or On-Post Family Housing, Senior Enlisted Quarters and Bachelor Officer Quarters may travel to off-post facilities within 20 kilometers of the place of residence only for carrying out professional activities and procuring essential consumer goods or services.

b. Local travel only. Travel is authorized for any purpose, but is limited to within 50 kilometers of the place of residence. Overnight stays outside a private home or assigned quarters are prohibited.

c. Travel is authorized within the German state of Bavaria.

d. Travel is authorized within Germany.

e. Travel to the following locations is prohibited: N/A.

f. Travel is authorized to and through Germany, Poland, Switzerland, Denmark, Czech Republic, Austria, Italy, France, Belgium, Luxembourg, and the Netherlands, unless the destination is listed as a “risk area” by the Robert Koch Institute (RKI) (link at “g.” below).

g. Travel is authorized to any destination, unless the destination is listed as a “risk area” by the Robert Koch Institute (RKI):

**3. MODE OF TRAVEL.** Exception authority to this paragraph is O-5/GS-14 Commanders or Supervisors.

a. Travel is limited to POV only, and only with members of a single household, unless car-pooling to a work or duty location.

b. Travel is limited to POV only, and only with members of up to 2 households, unless car-pooling to a work or duty location.

c. Travel is limited to ground transportation (automobile, bus, or train). Travel by commercial air is prohibited. Vacation travel on cruise ships is prohibited. This does not prohibit use of ferry boats or short-duration boat trips not involving an overnight stay on the vessel (for example, a 2-hour harbor cruise, or use of a ferry boat to an island).

d. Mode of travel is unrestricted.

**4. GROUPS, SOCIALIZING, AND ASSEMBLIES.** I am the exception authority.

a. Parties or other social gatherings are strictly prohibited. Individuals will avoid contact with anyone outside the immediate household.

b. Parties or other social gatherings are prohibited. However, members of the same household may socialize with members of one other household at a residence or in public without constituting a "party" or "social gathering."

c. Parties or social gatherings are limited. At a residence and in public, members of the same household may socialize with members of one other household, or in a group of no more than 10 total people of various households. Official/unofficial functions and socializing in commercial establishments, where contact tracing and hygiene protocols are in place in accordance with Host Nation law, are not prohibited.

d. Parties or social gatherings are only limited by Host Nation law. Guidance on applicable Host Nation law will be published at Tab 1 to this Annex.

**5. OFF-LIMITS ESTABLISHMENTS.** I am the exception authority.

a. Soldiers will not visit off-post bars, night clubs, dance clubs, or hookah lounges. Biergartens and restaurants that serve alcohol to seated patrons and enforce contact tracing and hygiene protocols are not prohibited.

b. Soldiers may patronize any establishment that Host Nation authorities deem safe to operate, but must abide by all Host Nation rules for their safe operation.
