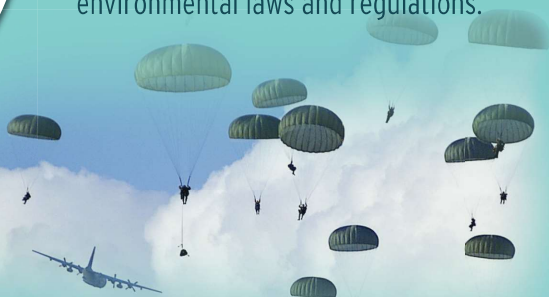


Support the Military Training Mission



Deliver realistic training environments

We actively promote mission readiness by continually assessing and upgrading environmental performance across the Garrison and ensuring compliance with environmental laws and regulations.



Provide facilities and equipment

Our technical solutions help Soldiers stay in compliance with legal requirements and minimize environmental impacts or risks of military training activities.

Refueling sites enable safe refueling of military vehicles at many locations throughout the training areas. In addition, there are six mobile refueling sites within Hohenfels Training Area for use during training maneuvers.

More than **300 hazardous waste accumulation points** all over Grafenwoehr and Hohenfels training areas make it easy for Soldiers to properly store and dispose of hazardous waste. Hazardous waste is picked up on a regular basis.

Washing military vehicles returning from training in muddy areas consumes a lot of water. Each installation in the Garrison operates **closed-system wash racks** to minimize the use of water and the generation of wastewater.



Promote spill prevention and response

We provide Soldiers with guidance on how to prevent spills and respond if a spill happens. As a member of the Garrison spill response team, we help with clean-up procedures and disposal of contaminated soil.

Support construction projects

Through the **environmental review and mitigation process**, we evaluate the environmental impact of construction projects, coordinate between project stakeholders, planners, and authorities, and provide data on soil, groundwater, and building materials.
